Permit and Permit Application for Overweight and Overdimension Vehicles

Permit Provisions:

Undertaking of the permit move is deemed Prima Facie evidence of acceptance of the permit and that:

- 1) The permittee is in compliance with all operation requirements;**
- 2) All dimensions and weight limitations specified in the permit shall not be exceeded;**
- 3) All operation, registration and license requirements have been complied with;**
- 4) All financial responsibilities, obligations and other legal requirements have been met;**
- 5) The permittee assumes all responsibility for injury or damage to persons or to public or private property, including his own, or to the object being transported caused directly or indirectly by the transportation or movement of vehicles and objects authorized under this permit. He agrees to hold harmless from all suits, claims, damages, or proceedings of any kind and to indemnify the Village of Lake in the Hills and HR Green, Inc. for any claim they may be required to pay arising from the movement.**
- 6) This permit shall be carried in the vehicle to which this permit applies at all times while operating on streets within the Village of Lake in the Hills and shall be exhibited to any enforcement officer, police officer, or other authorized official of the Village of Lake in the Hills.**
- 7) Whenever any vehicle is operated in violation of the provisions of a Village permit whether it be by size, weight or general provisions, and either or both the owner of the driver of such vehicle shall be deemed guilty and either or both the owner or the driver of such vehicle may be prosecuted for such violation.**
