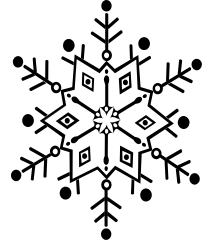




Inclement Weather Procedures



The Lake in the Hills Parks and Recreation Department established an Inclement Weather Policy in case classes need to be cancelled. Different procedures are outlined in the event of inclement weather and the decision of whether or not to cancel a program will be based off of the location of that event.

Contracted Locations: Programs that take place at outside contracted locations, it will be at the discretion of that organization whether or not to cancel a program (i.e. Focus Martial Arts, Handmade on Main, Players Choice Academy, etc).

Schools: Activities that take place at one of the schools will be cancelled if that school district is closed or has early release on the day of the program.

Village Sites: If a program is scheduled to take place at a Village site (i.e. Facility, Park, Shelter, etc.) that program will be cancelled if the school district for which that program site is located is also closed or had early release. The Village may also cancel programs as it deems necessary.

If at any time an instructor is unable to make it to a program location, that program will be cancelled.
