Registration Requirements:

1. Proof of residency.
2. Proof of valid rabies vaccination **and** distemper vaccination certificate for the dog or proof from your vet or a vet receipt.
3. Proof of adoption/rescue/purchase date of dog. Owner must have had possession of the dog for at least six (6) months.

Please read and initial the Bark Park Rules and Regulations, Dog Conflicts, Warning of Risk, and Waivers listed on page 2 of this form; and then sign and date the Household Acknowledgement section.

Forms that are not signed will not be processed, resulting in a delay in receipt of key fobs, dog tags, and access to the Bark Park.

Lake in the Hills Bark Park Rules and Regulations

The Lake in the Hills Dog Bark Park is located on Haligus Road just across from Sunset Park and is a 10-acre park.

Bark Park Rules

Initial

- Admittance is by key fob and dog tag. Prior registration is required.
- Hours are from dawn to 9:00 p.m. daily.
- Owner must clean up after their dog. Bags and receptacles are available on site.
- The following activities or items are prohibited within the confines of the park: Food of any kind including dog treats, littering, bikes, climbing over the fences. Dog equipment must only be used by dogs; no adults or children permitted on equipment.
- Gate Safety: Do not enter the corral area if another dog is inside. Dogs must be leashed until inside the gated area. You must have a leash with you at all times.
- Dogs must wear their membership dog tags at all times while at the park.
- Owner must have had possession of the dog for at least 6 months prior to registering. Proof of adoption, rescue, and/or purchase date is required.
- Owner must provide a certificate of valid rabies and distemper vaccinations for each dog or provide proof from your vet or a vet receipt.
- It is recommended that dogs have received the canine influenza vaccine.
- Dogs exhibiting aggressive behavior will not be allowed in the park. Aggressive behavior may result in revocation of park membership **with no refund**.
- Owner is responsible for any harm their dog inflicts on any other dog or human.
- Dogs in heat are not allowed in the park.
- Unhealthy dogs are not allowed in the park.
- Dogs must have a handler over the age of 18 present at all times.
- Children must be age 6 or older to be in the park and must be accompanied by an adult.
- Handler is responsible for controlling his/her dog at all times.
- There is a limit of two (2) dogs per person.
- Water is available on site; please bring a water dish and take it home with you.
- Smoking, alcohol, and glass containers are NOT ALLOWED at the park.
- Failure to abide by the Bark Park Rules and Regulations may result in the revocation of membership **with no refund**.
- Early termination of membership by an owner will not result in a refund.
- Owner is responsible for any damage their dog inflicts on any property within the park, including filling up any holes the dog creates. Hole filling stations are located in the park.
- Owner may not let non-members or other dogs into the park. Owner may not let non-household members use Owner's key fob or dog tag.

Dog Conflicts

Initial

Due to the concentration of dogs, dog conflicts may occur. It is the responsibility of the owners/handlers to maintain control of their dogs. To prevent injuries, supervise your dog(s) at all times. **Owner is responsible for their dog and any injuries the dog may cause. If your dog inflicts an injury, immediately leash your dog, provide your name and phone number to those involved, and leave the park. In case of emergency (dog bite or dangerous behavior), immediately call 911 for assistance. To register a complaint about aggressive dog behavior, call the Parks and Recreation Department at 847-960-7400. Complaints about aggressive dog behavior will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis and may result in revocation of membership with no refund. Dog bites that injure another dog or person need to be reported to the Lake in the Hills Police for a record detailing the event.**

Liability Waiver

Initial

Owner agrees owner is solely responsible for supervising owner's dog and determining whether or not this is an appropriate activity in which to participate. Owner understands and agrees that participating in this activity is at your own risk (and risk of your dog). Owner agrees owner is solely responsible for determining if you and/or your dog are physically and temperamentally fit and/or adequately skilled to use the park. It is always advisable, especially if you or your dog is pregnant, disabled in any way, or recently suffered an illness, injury, or impairment, to consult a physician or veterinarian before using the park.

Household Acknowledgement

I understand this membership covers my household and allows any member 18 years or older to use the dog Bark Park. As the primary membership holder, I am solely responsible for ensuring all eligible household members understand and follow the park rules, regulations, and waiver of liability. I acknowledge that I have informed all eligible household members of the waiver, and by use of the park they agree to comply.

Warning of Risk

Initial

Dog activities are intended to provide a fun and rewarding experience for a dog and its owner. However, despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning, and equipment, there is still a risk of serious injury, including death to either the dog or its owner.

Dogs are pack animals and when off leash, even the best-trained dogs will act instinctively. Understandably, not all hazards and dangers associated with dog activities can be foreseen. Certain inherent risks include the propensity of any dog to behave in dangerous ways that may result in injury to another person or dog. Other risks include, but are not limited to the inexperience, negligence, or irresponsibility of an owner; the inability to predict a dog's reaction to sound, movements, objects, persons, or other animals; and actions by the dog due to fright, anger, stress, insect bites, or natural reactions such as jumping, pulling, resisting, and biting. Other risks also include the hazards associated with environmental and traffic conditions, acts of God, inclement weather, slipping, falling, premises defects, failure in instruction and or supervision, and all other circumstances inherent to dog activities and outdoor activities.

Should you attempt to break up a fight between dogs, you may be attacked by the dogs.

Owner hereby recognizes that it is impossible for the Village of Lake in the Hills to guarantee absolute safety.

Waiver and Release of all Claims and Indemnification Agreement

Initial

Please read this form carefully and be aware that in consideration for permission to use this park, you are expressly assuming the risk and legal liability and WAIVING and RELEASING all claims for injuries, damages, or loss which you or your dog might sustain as a result of participating in any and all activities connected with and associated with presence upon and use of the park. By entering the park, you accept all posted rules, regulations, and liability waivers. All individuals using the park do so at their own risk and hold the Village of Lake in the Hills, including its officials, agents, volunteers, and employees, harmless from accident, injury, or damage occurring while utilizing the park.

I recognize and acknowledge that there are certain risks of physical injury to a dogs and its owner/handler in association with participating in dog activities, and I voluntarily agree to abide by all applicable rules and assume the full risk of any injuries, damages or loss, regardless of severity, that I/handler might sustain as a result of participating in any and all activities connected with or associated with use of the park.

I hereby agree to waive, relinquish, release and forever discharge the Village of Lake in the Hills, including its officials, agents, volunteers, and employees, from any and all claims for injuries, damages or loss that I/handler may have or which may occur to me/handler and arising out of, connected with, or in any way associated with the use of this facility or surrounding area. I further agree to INDEMNIFY and hold harmless and defend the Village of Lake in the Hills from and against any and all losses, injuries, claims, damages, liabilities, cause of actions, and expenses (including attorney fees), on account of personal injuries or death to any person or dogs, or damages to property occurring, growing out of, incident to, or resulting directly or indirectly from my and my dog's use of the park or surrounding area.

To ensure safe and enjoyable programs and facilities for all participants, the Village of Lake in the Hills has developed the following Code of Conduct. Participants in programs and those using facilities shall:

- Show respect to all participants, staff, equipment, supplies, and facilities.
- Refrain from using offensive or profane language.
- Refrain from aggressive behavior that could cause bodily harm.

The Village reserves the right to dismiss a participant from a program or revoke future participation privileges in programs and/or at facilities if the participant's behavior or language is deemed inappropriate by staff.
